I wanted to write and give you a few resources that might help you out this week if you are looking for a few learning activities to do. Let me know if you have any questions.

-Our letter this week is W. To make it we say, big slant down, big slant up, big slant down, big slant up. It makes the "wuh" sound. You can have your child try to write it in the air, on paper, or on an easel. Another activity that students enjoy is using playdough to create letters. When we do this we try to roll out our lines and connect them. You may find that rolling playdough into a line can be tricky for 3 and 4 year olds!

-Usually for letter W we do some wind themed music and movement activities. One funny song I like to have the kids dance and do movements to is, "It's the Wind." I am including a link if you want to give it a listen and burn some energy with moving along to it!
